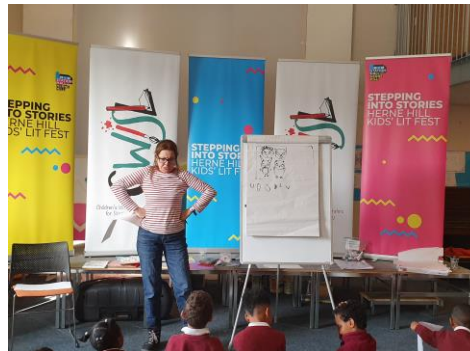


## Stepping into Stories Herne Hill Kids' Literature Festival

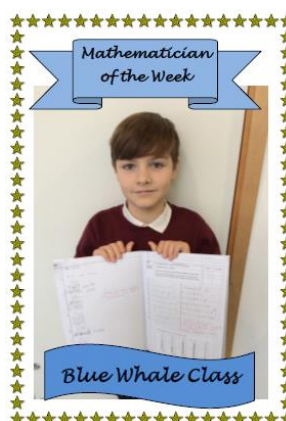

Penguin Class



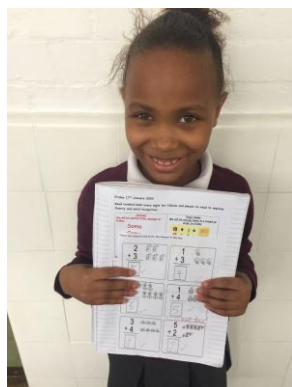
Lion Class
