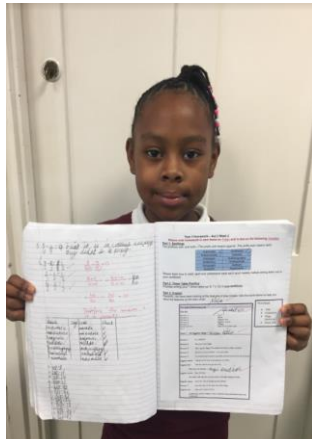
YEAR 4 TRIP TO TATE BRITAIN

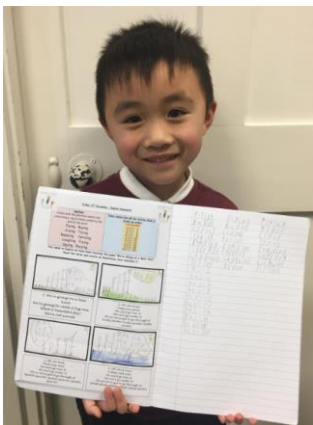

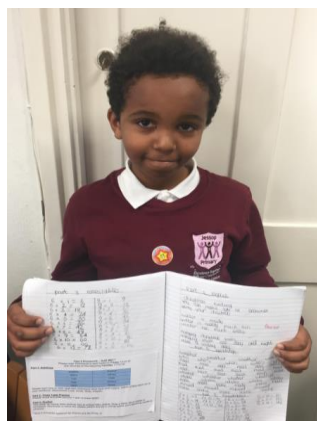
Gorilla Class
