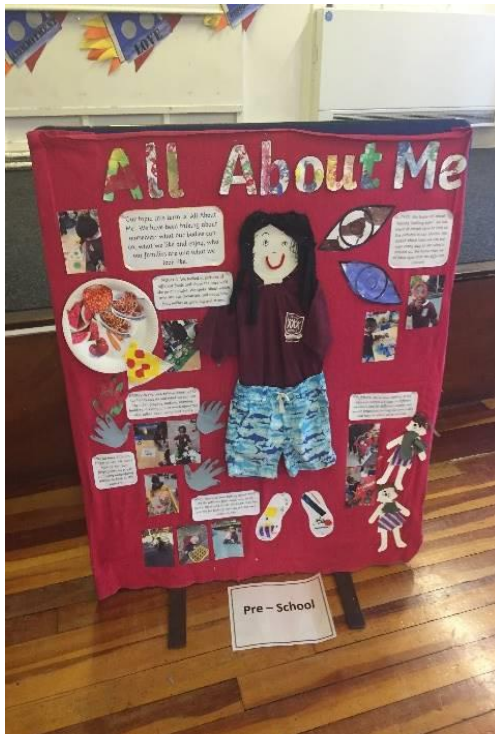


EXHIBITION OF WORK

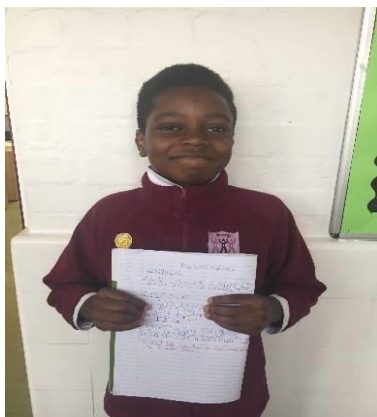

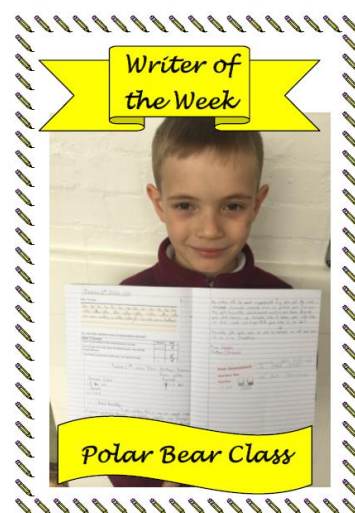

Koala Class



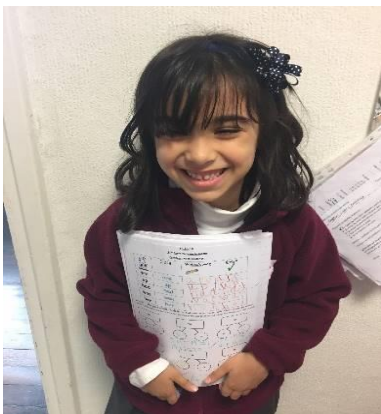
Polar Bear Class



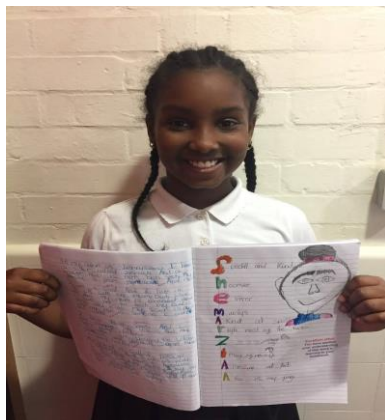

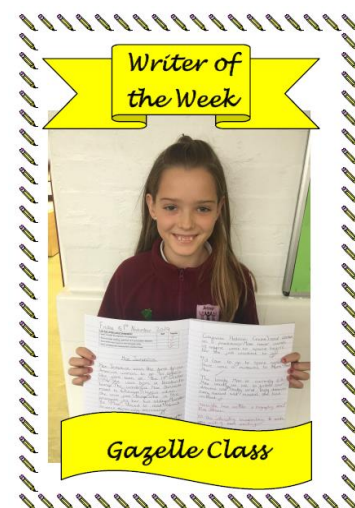
