What we're learning about:

Play scripts, poetry, letters and postcards

What we will do:

We will begin the term by delving into the book *Tuesday* by David Wiesner. Following on from this we will develop our knowledge of writing play scripts and link this to our humanities learning. Next we will spend time writing beach poems using onomatopoeias and alliteration.

Maths

What we're learning about:

Fractions, geometry, symmetry, measuring and statistics

What we will do:

We will review our learning from this year and consolidate what we already know to prepare us for year 3. We will also be taking part in Money Week where we will fundraise for a special treat that will be decided by the children.

What we will do:

We will have a particular focus on the Victorian Era and how transport allowed people to travel more freely to different areas of the country i.e. the beach! We will also look at the geographical vocabulary associated with the seaside.
