What we will do:

Children will learn a traditional tale, they will use talk for writing in order to memorise all the wow words.

They will change the text by using their own ideas and at the end they will write an outstanding traditional tale. Children will learn the structure of a letter and emails. They will write their own email to a family member or a friend.

MATHS

They will continue to work on recalling all their times tables and their division match.

Children will learn the importance of collecting evidence by making observations and measurements through answering questions. They will use questioning techniques like how, why and what will happen if. And decide how they might answer these questions.

Children will use first-hand experience and simple information sources to answer questions.

Children will learn how to recognise when a test or comparison is fair or unfair.

Children will learn about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. Children will secure their chronological knowledge of events in the time. Children will explore the Roman way of life and identify similarities and differences to their own lives.
