What we're learning about:

Traditional Tales

What we will do:

Children will use the *Just So Stories* by Rudyard Kipling to inspire their own short story writing and study the morals of different fables from around the world. The unit will end by linking to our history topic of Ancient Egypt and writing information texts.

Maths

What we're learning about:

Fractions, geometry, measure and statistics.

What we will do:

Children will consolidate their learning in these areas. They will revisit comparing numbers with the same number of decimal places up to 2 digit places, describe positions on 2D grids as coordinates in the first quadrant, find the areas of rectilinear shapes, convert between different units of measures and interpret and present discrete and continuous data using appropriate graphical methods.

What we're learning about:

Investigation

What we will do

Children will be revising and consolidating their learning of previous concepts. They will apply their investigative skills to experiments on *States of Matter, Circuits and Conductors and Animals Including Humans (Digestive System)*

Humanities

What we're learning about:

Ancient Egypt

What we will do:

We will be looking at the history of Ancient Egypt and discover about the famous "mummies", including Tutankhamun, that have made it infamous. We will look at how they lived and how artefacts can tell us about the past.
