Literacy

What we're learning about: We will explore our core books: 'Just Imagine' by Pippa Goodhart and 'Maisy Dresses Up' by Lucy Cousins.

What we will do:

We will continue to link sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet.

We will continue to practice writing our own name and begin to make labels for our pictures.
