Information for parents/carers of children born between 01/09/09 and 31/08/10, or taught as a year 6 child during the 2020/21 academic year, who will be transferring from primary to secondary school in September 2021

The Year 6 Secondary transfer parents meeting was held virtually on Wednesday the 16th September. A big thank you to all our parents and carers that attended. During the meeting, we also heard from Senior Leaders from local Secondary Schools including Kingsdale, St Martins, St Gabriel's, Alleyns, Elm Green and Evelyn Grace.

A quick reminder of the key messages:

- Apply online via <https://www.eadmissions.org.uk/>
- The deadline is Saturday 31st October 2020
- All applications must include proof of your address and proof that your child lives at that address
- All applications must include proof of your child's date of birth
- You can choose 6 schools in order of preference on the Common Application Form
- Remember to check if you also need to fill out a supplementary information form or if they require your child to sit a test
- Most importantly attend virtually or in person open days or evenings

Google Classroom

All schools are required to have an online learning platform that can be easily accessed should a local lockdown be enforced, or a 'Bubble' is required to be quarantined for 14 days. Therefore, in future, our children will access their learning using Google Classroom. As our readiness for this is essential, over the next few days (if you have not already) you will receive your child's login information from their class teacher. Whilst children are required to be in school, our Google Classroom will only be active for homework (assignments). Therefore, please ensure you login and familiarise yourself with the space. Once active, you will be able to see any messages from the teachers and view your child's assignments and feedback from their class teacher.
