### Jessop School Council Members meet Junior Road Watch

Last week our School Council members took part in a national initiative 'Junior Road Watch', a new road danger reduction education scheme which aims to reduce speeding near schools. Jessop Primary school was visited by Will Norman (The Mayor's Road Safety lead) and the Metropolitan Police Service Roads & Transport Policing Command. The whole school enjoyed a special assembly in which a clear message was given to pupils regarding the dangers of speeding on our roads and the impact of cars on our environment.

The School Council members took part in an enforcement exercise in Milkwood Road. Inspector Carpenter showed the children how to catch speeding drivers, by using speed guns to record their speed. The children each took turns to use the speed guns and were given a talk regarding the dangers of speeding on a 20mph road. There was a total of 13 offenders reported in the space of 3 hours (measured by police, not the children!) A successful day was had by all!

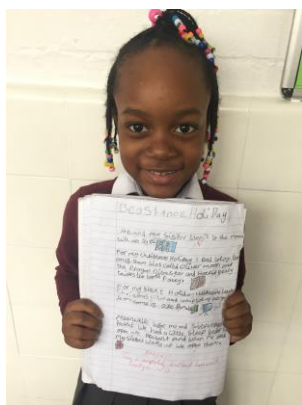




## Coffee Morning

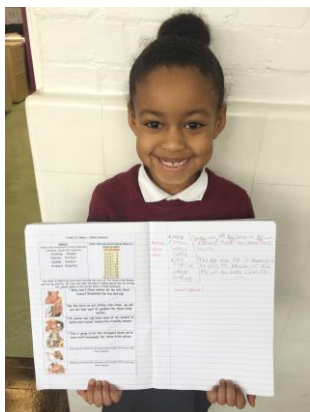

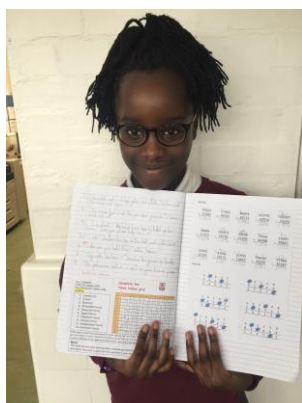
