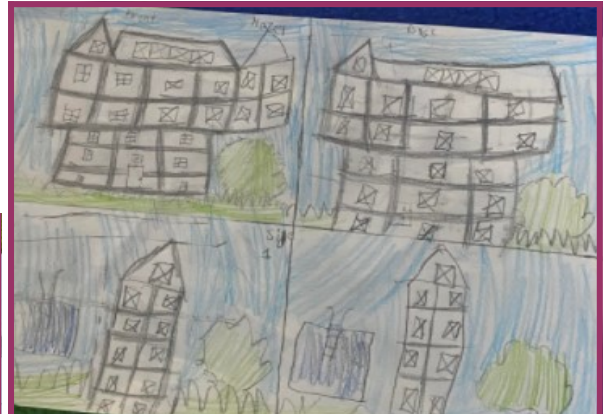

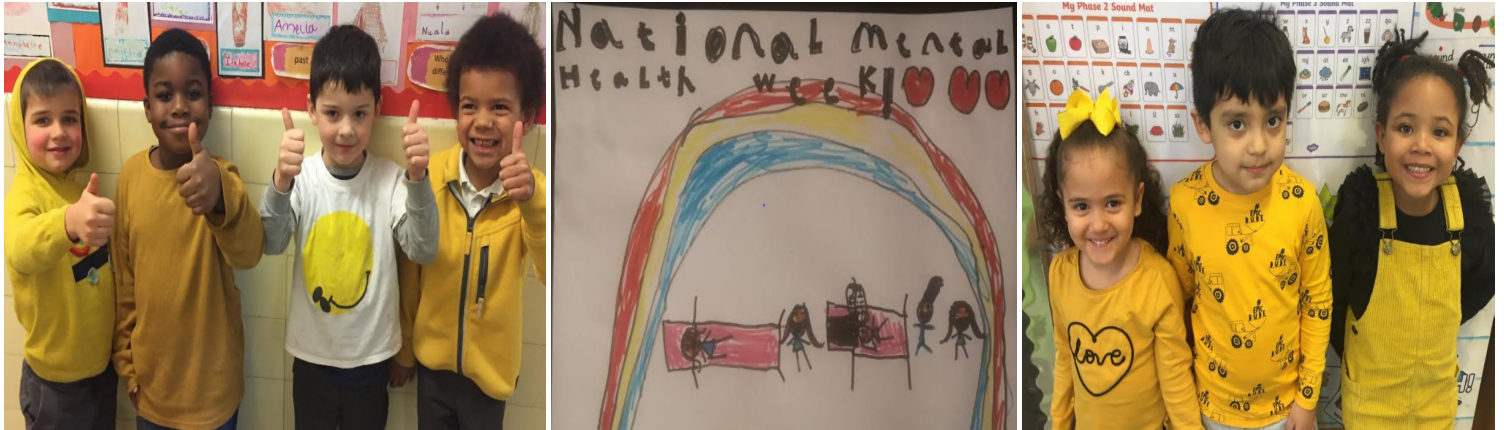

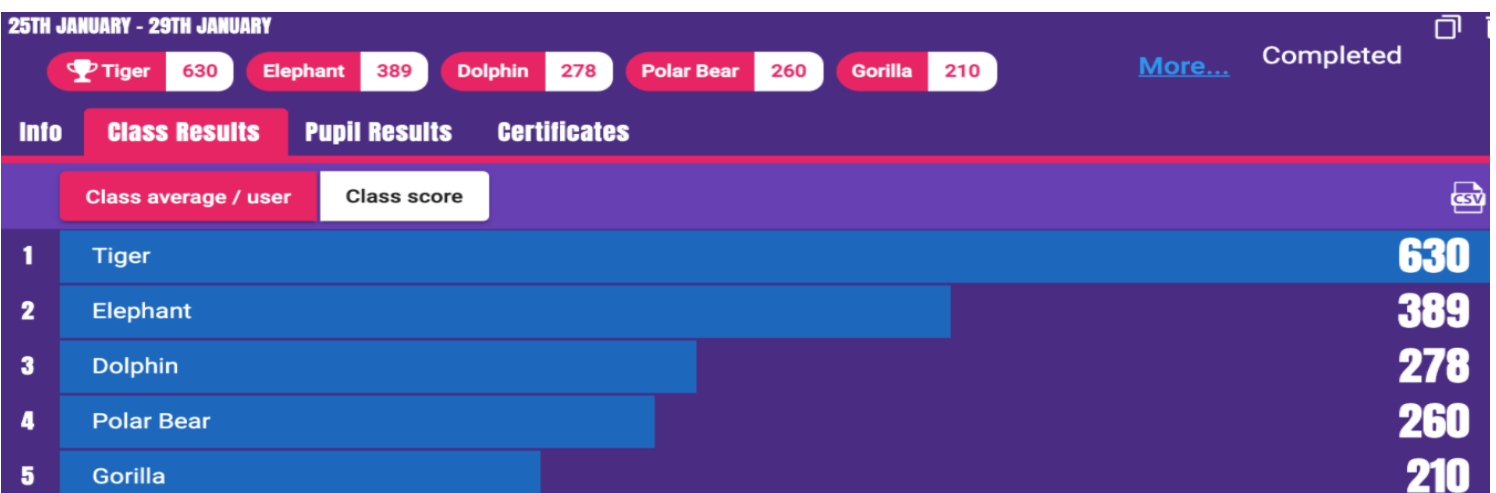
Children's Mental Health Week

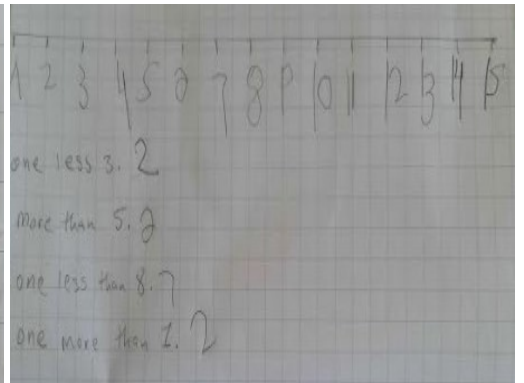
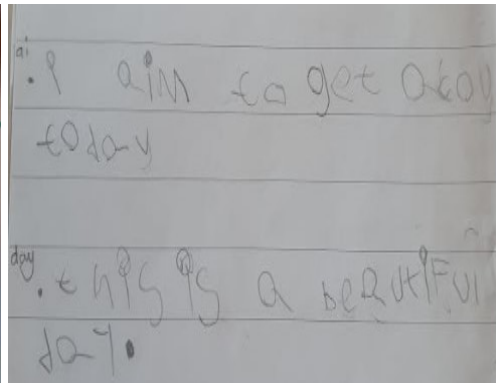
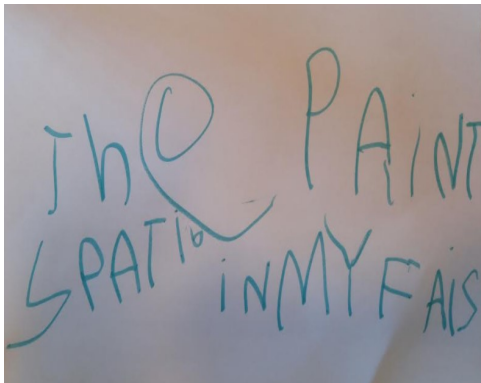
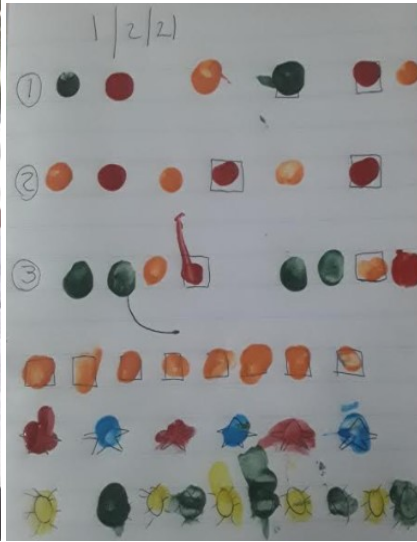
PRE- SCHOOL

Always stay on mute unless you are asked a question directly by the teacher

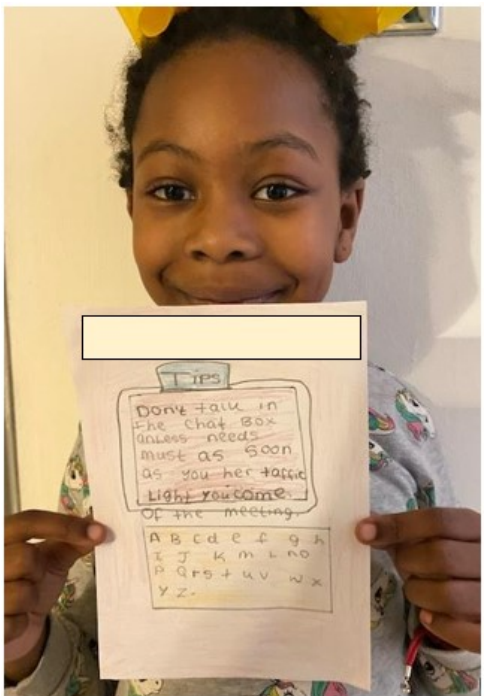
Tips for successful online learning

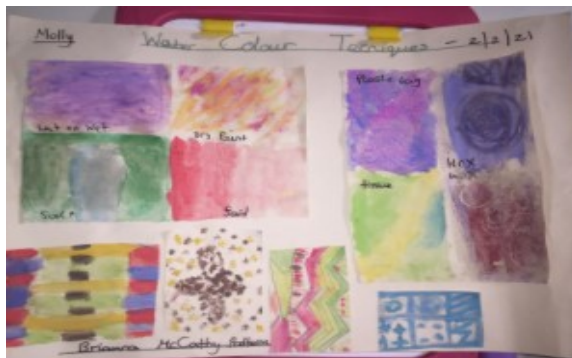

The Windsor

In Britain 1798 the Empire Windsor sailed from Kingston Jamaica and docked at the Port of Tilbury on the 22nd of June. Around 400 passengers aboard had come from Jamaica to work in Britain and start a new life. The Empire Windsor was originally MV Marie Rose and was a passenger liner and cruise ship. In world war II it was used by the German navy but was taken by the British Government as a prize of war.

Britain in 1948

The war had a big impact on Britain and even though it had ended in 1945 there was a lot that needed to be done to rebuild the country. Many homes and buildings had been destroyed by bombs and there was a shortage of labour and people to do jobs to help rebuild the country and make it successful again.

In 1954 the Empire Windsor caught on fire after a sudden explosion on board. The vessel sank two days later in the Mediterranean sea.

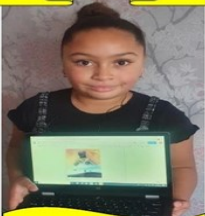

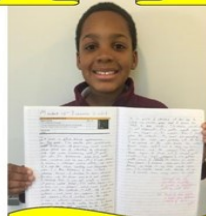

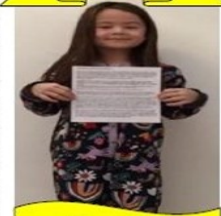
