Re: Homework expectations

The children have made a fantastic start to the new year and we are really happy they have settled so well. Thank you for all your continued support with this. We know parents are always very keen to support their children at home and we hope this letter will be helpful in supporting you to do so. One of the best ways to do this is by simply talking with your child about their school day and their learning experiences. One of our whole school priorities is to develop children's use of high-quality dialogue and new vocabulary in the classroom to support independent and collaborative learning.

EYFS

Daily reading for at least 10 minutes.

1 practical/recorded activity based on the 'Book of the Week'

Reading/Spellings - 6 Tricky Words

Google Classroom - Friday homework will be uploaded by teachers onto Google Classroom by 5.00 pm. Children should complete the task in their homework book or sheet. Parents and carers should take a photo of the completed task and upload it onto Google Classroom by the end of the day on the following Tuesday.

KEY STAGE ONE

Daily reading for at least 15 minutes.

Spellings - Year 1: 5 tricky words plus 5 Phonics Spellings and Year 2: 10 tricky words. Children are tested every Friday.

Google Classroom - Friday homework will be uploaded by teachers onto Google Classroom by 5.00 pm. Children complete the task in their homework book or sheet. Parents and carers should take a photo of the completed task and upload it onto Google Classroom by the end of the day on the following Tuesday.

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KEY STAGE TWO

Daily reading for at least 30 minutes.

Spellings - 10 words and children are tested every Friday. In addition, children will be given times tables to learn weekly.

Google Classroom - Friday homework will be uploaded by teachers onto Google Classroom by 5.00 pm. Children complete the task in their homework book or sheet. Parents and carers should take a photo of the completed task and upload it onto Google Classroom by the end of the day on the following Tuesday.

We hope you will find this information helpful. Please do not hesitate to speak with your child/rens class teacher if you have any questions about homework. You can contact class teachers directly through Google classroom, via year group email, the school office email/phone, or in person at dismissal times. You can also make an appointment to meet with your child's class teacher at a specific time.
