On Thursday 5th May, we had an extremely informative coffee morning hosted by our Speech and Language therapist, Amy Lever. The focus of our discussion was strategies to support verbal reasoning skills during reading time.

We looked at what verbal reasoning is, why this skill is so important and then looked at the 3 key strategies to support children with this.

- 1. Comment at least 3 times before asking questions
- 2. Pre- teach new vocabulary
- 3. Use levels of questioning

World Down Syndrome Day 2022


Each year on the 21st of March we celebrate World Down Syndrome Day. People with Down syndrome have an extra chromosome


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
