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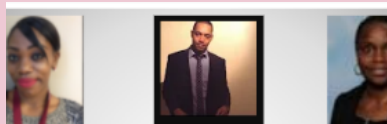


Year 6 Secondary Transfer Meeting

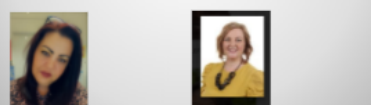
The Year 6 Secondary School Transfer Meeting took place on Wednesday 15th September and this was held virtually. A huge thank you to all our parents, carers and the senior leaders from 6 of our local secondary schools that attended.

The key points/take away from the meeting:

1. Please visit or attend virtually open days/evenings with your child.
2. All must apply via <https://www.eadmissions.org.uk/>
3. The deadline for all applications is Sunday 31st October 2021.
4. You can choose 6 schools and must select them in order of preference on the CAF (Common Application Form).
5. All applications must include 2 proof of address of the parent or carer and one that proves that your child lives at that address.
6. All applications must include proof of your child's date of birth.
7. Remember to check with the individual schools if you need a SIF (Supplementary Information Form) OR if your child needs to sit a test.
8. For any further information or support, please feel free to contact us. We will be having regular surgeries to support you with your child's application. these will be held at school on Thursday 30th September and Thursday 7th October at 09:15
