

Resubmitting an application will help us to understand what's changed, as some people may have moved out of the borough or gained access to a hangar. We want to make sure we have the most up to date information that reflects our existing residents.

Please resubmit your application using the <u>online form</u> by 18 March 2022. If we don't hear back from you, your application will not be included, as we will assume you no longer have an interest in a cycle hangar on your street.

Please note that there is an extremely high level of demand for cycle hangars across the borough and that we are doing our best to address this.
