What made it happen?

Why wouldn't... (the boy run)?  
What could we use... (to fix it)?  
Where will... (the ball go)?  
What will happen if...?

On Thursday 5th May, we had an extremely informative coffee morning hosted by our Speech and Language therapist, Amy Lever. The focus of our discussion was strategies to support verbal reasoning skills during reading time.

We looked at what verbal reasoning is, why this skill is so important and then looked at the 3 key strategies to support children with this.

1. Comment at least 3 times before asking questions
2. Pre- teach new vocabulary
3. Use levels of questioning

This year we celebrated by having a fantastic assembly with Mr Baffoe and also by wearing #lotsofsocks

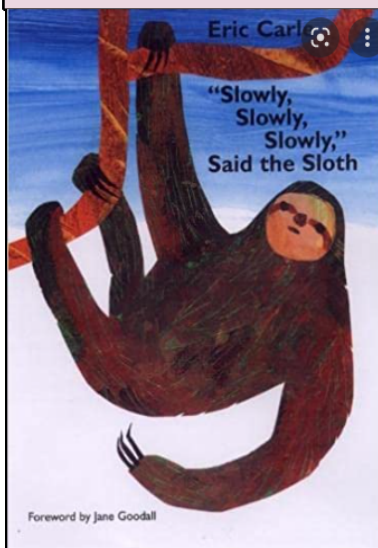
