# SAYERS CROFT

- ▶ Sayers Croft Field Centre was built in 1939 as part of the Camp Schools Programme to provide an educational base for city children to visit and learn about the countryside. However, at the outbreak of World War II the following year, the centre became home to evacuees from London.
- ▶ After the war the centre returned to its original purpose, to provide residential visits for schools where children could study science, geography and a wealth of other hands on subjects in the natural environment.
- ▶ The centre still has all of the original buildings as well as original air raid shelters but a lot has changed in 70 years!

# SAYERS CROFT

- ▶ The cost of the visit will be £338.00 and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities.
- ▶ If you would like your child to go, you must pay a deposit of £43 by 14th October 2022
- ▶ You can pay the remaining cost of £295 by the 15th May 2023 in one instalment or you are welcome to pay in smaller instalments.

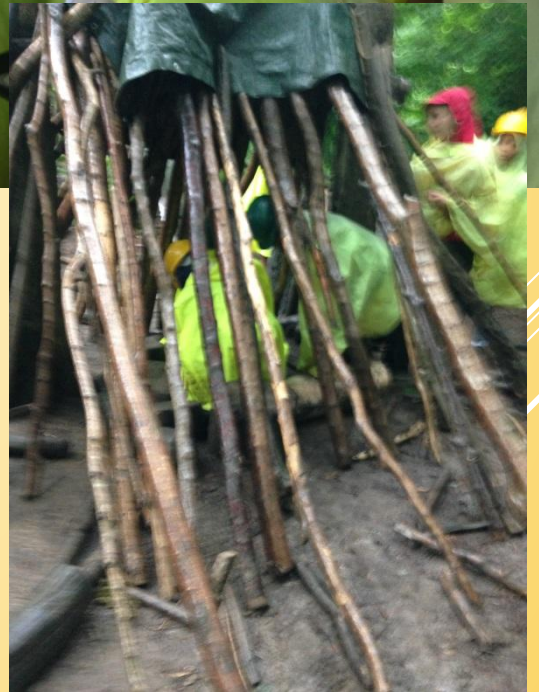
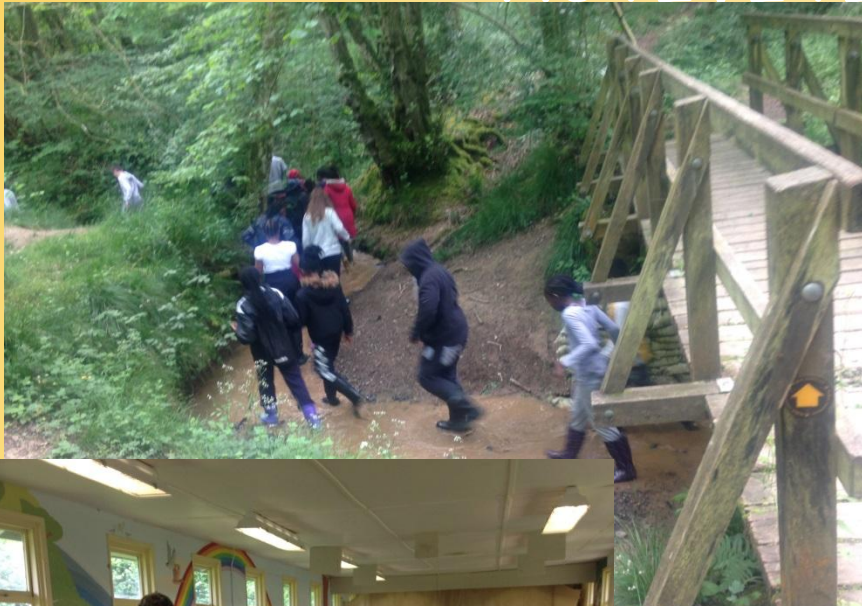

- ▶ If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give them their medication before travel and please provide some for him or her to take with them on the trip.

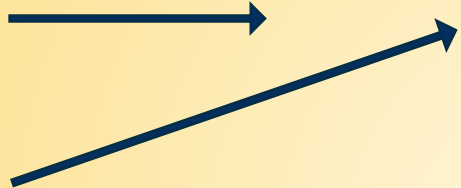
## OTHER:

  - ▶ NO electronic games, mobile phones or valuables.
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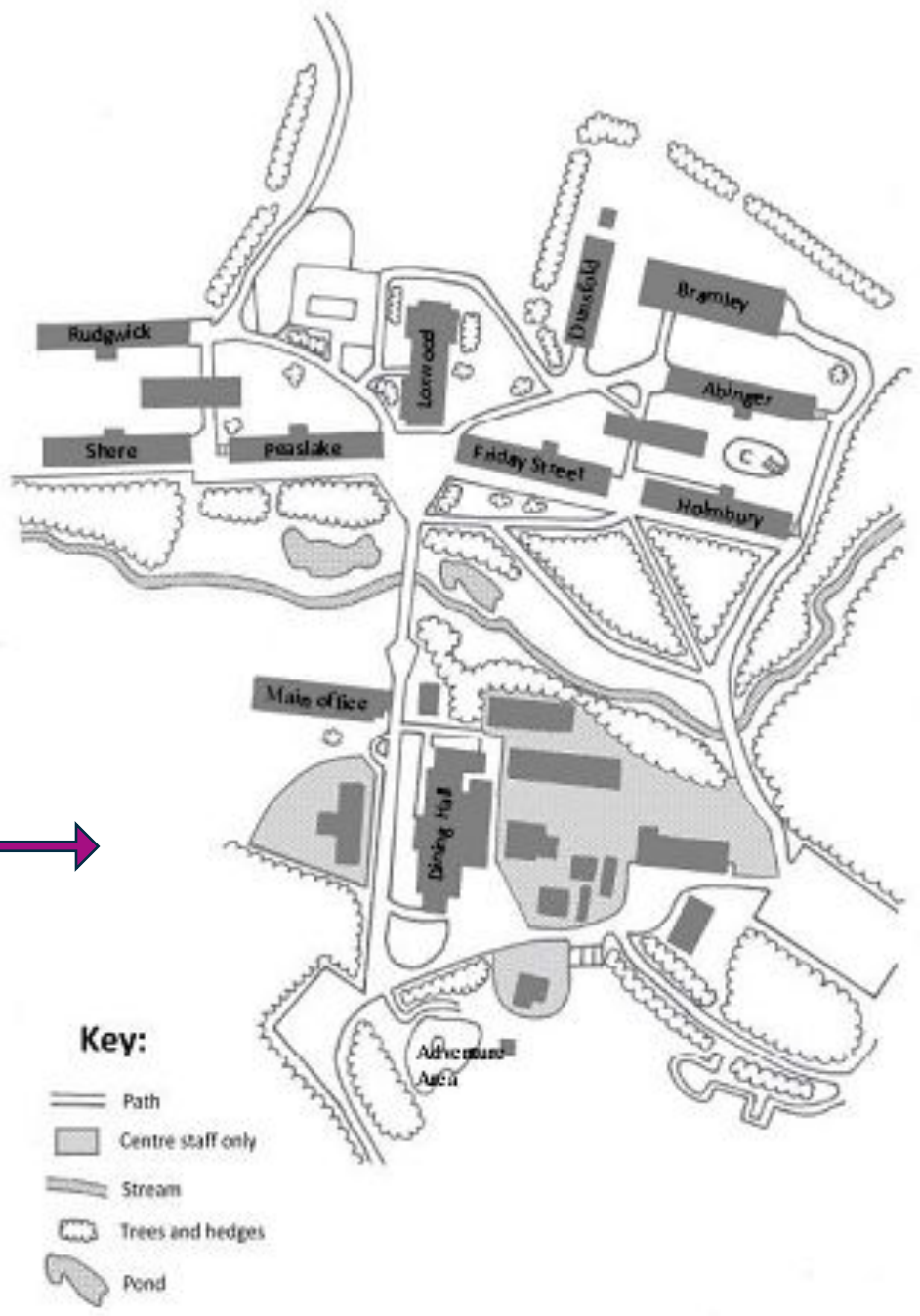
# MEALS
