What is GameChanger Grants?

GameChanger Grants is grant giving programme that supports young Londoners to run youth-led community action projects. The money helps young people make their ideas happen from litter picks to cultural community days, playground gardens to anti-bullying campaigns.

In order to get the ball rolling on this and access the grant, your child has been selected to attend an online workshop on Friday 2nd December in the morning. Each workshop lasts one hour and allows time for each student to complete their personal letter to London. In each letter, students propose how they would create tangible change to their school and their community – a fantastic opportunity for young people to develop their persona writing skills.
