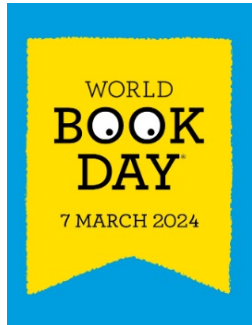


Extreme Reading Competition World Book Day Thursday 7th March 2024



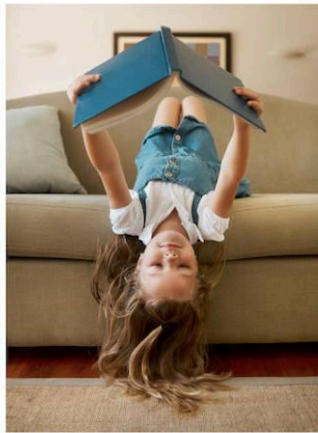
Where is the most interesting place you have ever read a book?
