Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: MOBILE PHONES

We write to remind you of the school's strict "no mobile phone" policy for pupils.

Mobile phones for pupils are unwelcome at Jessop and should not be seen or used on school premises at any point during the school day. There is a wealth of research documenting how the use of mobile phones negatively affects children's day-to-day engagement in their learning and, inevitably, their overall outcomes.

At the beginning of the academic year, pupils have been reminded about mobile phone procedures. Pupils who bring a mobile phone to school are required to hand their phone in at the office and this will be handed to them at the end of the day, as they leave to go home.

May we please ask if your child has been given permission to bring a mobile phone into school, you remind them of the rules set out. Breaking these rules can put all of our pupils and staff at risk and may prevent us from allowing pupils to bring in mobile phones, even in exceptional circumstances.

May we also take this opportunity to remind you that, if your child has been given permission to bring a mobile phone into school, they do so at their own risk. The school will not accept liability for lost, damaged or stolen phones.
